St. Paul's School, Rana, Gogunda was founded on the 1st of July 2014 as an institution with a Mission for the cause of Education with a vision. It is a private, unaided, Catholic Minority Institution, recognized by Rajasthan Educational Board. It is governed and managed by The Catholic Diocesan Education Society, Udaipur.

ST. PAUL - PATRON OF OUR SCHOOL

Every institution has a patron or patroness who serves as a model. His or her life serves as a source of inspiration, encouragement and motivation to all. Children in a school ought to have a role model too so that they have an opportunity to imbibe moral and spiritual values along with learning. Mere knowledge of various subjects does not render education complete. They must grow in knowledge, virtue and wisdom in order to be good humans, upright citizens and attain greatness to make our Nation proud.

ST. PAUL - APOSTLE TO ALL

Saint Paul, popularly known as the Apostle of the Gentiles is undoubtedly one of the most important figures in the history of the Western world.

St. Paul was born in Tarsus, one of the towns in Cilicia, a Roman Province, in the year 5 A.D. He was named after the first Jewish king Saul and an added Roman name Paulus according to the custom. He was sent to Jerusalem and there he received a thorough Hebrew education in the school of Gamaliel, the great Doctor of the Law. Being a staunch Jew he began to persecute the Christians. It is on the way to Damascus that he encountered Jesus the Lord which led him to become an ardent believer of Jesus.

Being a philosopher, theologian and scholar St. Paul was a literary figure of Par Excellence. He is the greatest religious genius that Christianity has ever had. Though two thousand years old, his writings are still inspiring and instilling.



He was arrested during the persecution of Christians by Nero. He was beheaded outside the gates of the city of Rome on the 29th of June in the year 67 AD (CE)

Being an intellectual and a hardworking person with great will power, he is the patron of many Christian educational institutions all over the world. May St. Paul, the patron of this institution at Rana, Gogunda, grant us the courage, strength and wisdom to be the bearers of Light in the field of education and the welfare of our nation.

RULES OF THE SCHOOL

1. Students are not granted leave of absence unless their parents/guardians send in an application and that too for serious reasons only. Those taking leave without the permission of the Principal are liable to dismissal. 90% attendance is a must for every student.
2. When a student falls ill, the Principal should be informed at the earliest and when he/she rejoins school, he/she must bring the excuse duly entered on the ABSENCE RECORD (in the diary, signed by the parent / guardian) failing which he/she may be refused admission to class. Sick leave for two or more than two days must be substantiated by a proper medical certificate. Advance written permission of the principal is required if a child is to be taken out of station during working days for more than two days. Students suffering from any Infectious disease like measles must complete the quarantine period before rejoining the school.
3. Students unable to rejoin classes after the holidays should take written permission from the Principal in advance. Defaulters in this regard may find their names struck off the rolls.
4. A student coming late to school will not be admitted to class unless he/she brings a written excuse from home on the LATE ATTENDANCE RECORD of the diary.
5. No student is allowed to leave the school premises during the school hours without the written permission of the Principal. No student will be allowed to go home during the class hours unless



one of the parents or guardians comes with a written application to take him/her.

6. Running about, playing or shouting inside the school building is strictly forbidden.
7. Any damage done to the school property will have to be compensated.
8. Students should see that they do not throw pieces of paper, seeds etc. anywhere in the school premises. They should use the dust bins provided for this purpose.
9. A student whose uniform or appearance is untidy may be refused admission to the class. If a student is not in school uniform, he/she shall get a letter from the parent/ guardian. Students should come to school in complete uniform only on all school days including all other activities. Without school uniform no transaction will be done with the student.
10. Any student reaching school after the first bell will not be allowed to enter the school premises. At the first bell, all must take their allotted places in silence for the morning assembly. After the assembly they are expected to go in silence to their respective classes.
11. When the students have to move along the corridors, while the classes are in progress, they should do so in silence.
12. No books - other than what is required for the classes or from the school library, may be brought to school.
13. The school is not responsible for the books, money, clothes etc. lost. The students should look after their own things. They are advised not to bring any valuables to school.
14. During the intermission the students are not allowed to enter the classrooms.
15. Students are expected to take part in the co-curricular activities as and when they are asked to do so.



16. Parents / guardians are expected to co-operate with the staff in enforcing regularity and discipline by seeing that their wards prepare their lessons, do their home-work as shown in diaries and by taking an active and helpful interest in the activities of the school.
17. Parents / guardians are allowed to meet the teachers only at the permitted time. They are not allowed to meet the students or interview the teachers during school hours or any other day without the written permission of the Principal.
18. Nobody is allowed to bring or use Mobile/Cell phones in the school campus. If a student is found with a mobile phone, it will be confiscated along with the simcard and will not be returned.
19. The parents must see that the date of birth filled in the application form of their children is correct as it will not be changed afterwards.
20. The parents are advised to see the School Diary, Progress Report of the children regularly to know the progress of the ward.
21. In case of accidents, school will provide only First Aid; other related expenses will be borne by parents / guardians / insurance company.
22. All the students are expected to bring only vegetarian food for tiffin. Parents must ensure that their wards have a healthy diet and avoid fast food and packed items as much as possible.

ADMISSION

Admission is open to boys and girls. No distinction is made on grounds of caste or creed.

The academic session begins in April and ends in March; normally only children who are above three will be admitted to the Nursery class. A corresponding age limit is set for the other classes too.

Except the beginners, all students, before being admitted must pass a test in the Core subjects. If a student has attended any other school, he/she must produce Progress Card, Transfer and Character Certificates from the previous school.



DISMISSAL

The Principal reserves to himself/herself the right of retaining students whose attendance is irregular, conduct harmful to others, lacking full participation in co-curricular activities or whose fees are not paid on time. Honesty, cleanliness of person and dress, good manners and loyalty are demanded of each student. Anyone not conforming to the school's ideals in these matters may, after due notice to his/her parents, be asked to leave. Immorality, grave insubordination and contempt of authority are always sufficient reasons for dismissal.

WITHDRAWAL

1. A calendar month's (30 days) notice is to be given in writing by the parent/guardian before the withdrawal of a pupil for facilitating the formalities involved in issuing a T.C. The regular school fees are expected to be cleared up to the date of the issuance of the T.C.
2. No school leaving certificate will be given until all sums due to the school have been paid in full.
3. The first T.C. is given at a nominal charge of Rs.50/- but a duplicate copy of 'ANY' certificate, Rs. 400/- will be charged. A character certificate is given only once at the end of one's school career.

EXAMINATION

1. Students absenting themselves from any of the examinations are not re-examined, whatever may be the reason. No student shall be promoted to the next class without appearing for 1st and 2nd Term Examinations.
2. The results of the examinations are final and will not be reconsidered.
3. The minimum marks required for passing in each subject shall be 36 percent.
4. Students who did not appear in one or more subjects in any of the examinations for unavoidable reasons only shall be considered for 'Promotion', provided they get their leave sanctioned in time by the principal. Students marginally failing in any one subject in the grand



total shall be considered for promotion through 'grace marks'. Students failing in two or more subjects in the grand total will not be promoted to the next class.

PROMOTION

Promotion for the students from their respective classes is granted on the basis of the quality of Regular and Satisfactory work done during the whole year. The Principal is the final judge of a student's fitness for promotion.

FEES

Tuition fees are charged for all months of the academic year. Fees are to be paid by the 15th of every month and with late fee up to 20th (Please see the school fee card for the details and follow). All dues up to that time must be cleared before a student is admitted for the 1st Term & 2nd Term Examinations.

- (e) to promote harmony and the spirit of common brotherhood amongst all the people of India transcending religious, linguistic and regional or sectional diversities, to renounce practices derogatory to the dignity of women.
- (f) to value and preserve the rich heritage of our composite culture.
- (g) to protect and improve the natural environment including forests, lakes, rivers and wild life and to have compassion for living creatures.
- (h) to develop the scientific temper, humanism and spirit of inquiry and reform.
- (i) to safeguard public property and to adjure violence.
- (j) to strive towards excellence in all spheres of individual and collective activity so that the nation constantly rises to higher levels of endeavour and achievement.

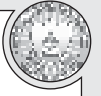
